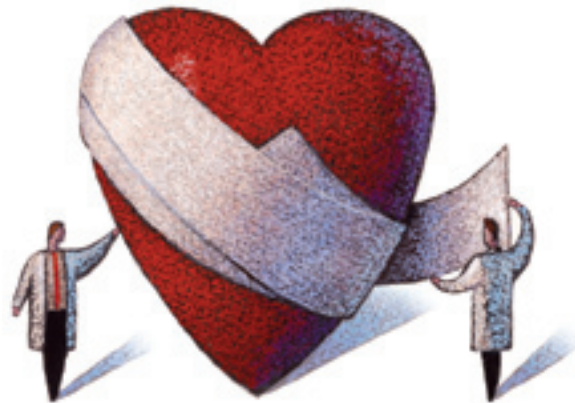

Medicare has expanded its coverage for cardiac rehab to include three additional diagnoses. Now, more of your patients can receive the proven benefits of cardiac rehab including those with:

- Heart valve repair/replacement
- Percutaneous transluminal coronary angioplasty (PTCA) or coronary stenting
- Heart or heart-lung transplant

These diagnoses, as you know, are already covered:

- Acute MI
- Coronary bypass surgery
- Stable angina pectoris

In addition, congestive heart failure, while not covered by Medicare, is covered by many commercial insurance companies.
