Cuba is home to one of the world's most pristine coral reefs. The crystal blue Caribbean waters off Desembarco del Granma National Park are home to Elkhorn Coral (CR), Staghorn Coral (CR), Boulder Star Coral (EN) and Mountainous Star Coral (EN). This haven for Great Hammerhead (CR), Oceanic Whitetip Shark (CR) and Caribbean Reef Shark (EN) is in danger. Overfishing, illegal fishing and climate change threaten to turn this vibrant coral reef into a ghost town.

Rainforest Trust is working with our local partners WCS and Antonio Nuñez Jimenez Foundation to establish a 359,743 acre marine protected area here. And we need your help.
